

## ***Exhibit Competition Regulations***

### **Submission Criteria**

Submissions from medical radiation technologists must include at least 80 per cent of their direct input / work. Assistance from any commercial firm or from a CAMRT member in the employ of a commercial firm is not permitted.

Where there is a joint submission, only the lead author is required to be a medical radiation technologist and a CAMRT member.

Submissions from students must have been completed during the training period and confirmation will be required that the submitter will still be a student at the time of the submission deadline.

Exhibit competition entries must not have been displayed at a previous CAMRT Annual General Conference.

Material drawn from award-winning essay competition entries will not be accepted, in whole or in part, for the exhibit competition.

To ensure a fair judging process, we request that the names of exhibitors, their hospitals or institutions or offices must be completely obscured until judging is completed. Failure to meet this requirement will result in be disqualification.

### **Submission process**

Complete the online entry form for the exhibit competition on the CAMRT website. Exhibits may be in the form of a PowerPoint presentation, a model, or a traditional poster. The preferred dimension for posters is maximum 4 feet by 4 feet (1.22 metres by 1.22 metres), but accommodation will be made for larger sized posters (maximum 4 feet by 8 feet or 1.22 metres x 2.44 metres) that may have been previously presented elsewhere. PowerPoint presentations will be displayed on a screen and will run in a continuous loop. The maximum running time in 'slide show' mode should be 3 minutes and the file should not be more than 5mb.

### **Deadline**

Online entry forms for the exhibit competition must be received by the CAMRT Office by midnight EDT March 29<sup>th</sup>.

### **Eligibility Exclusions**

The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the Exhibit competition: members of the CAMRT Board of Directors, association employees, the current year's exhibit competition

judges, CAMRT members who are employed by manufacturers of medical equipment, accessories or supplies in the field of medical radiation technology, and the current year's Welch Memorial Lecturer.

## **Liability**

Exhibitors assume full responsibility for their exhibit and the CAMRT is not responsible for any loss or damage. CAMRT will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of exhibits while on display.

## **Judging**

Entries to the exhibit competition are displayed at the Annual General Conference and are examined by a panel of volunteer judges from the disciplines of radiological technology, radiation therapy, nuclear medicine and magnetic resonance. Judging is conducted on site.

A minimum of 75% must be obtained before a winner will be declared in any category. Certificates of Merit will be awarded for exhibits that place within five (5) marks of the winning exhibit in each category. Qualifying entries in all exhibit categories are judged against the same criteria. Individual critique forms will be completed to assess:

• Educational value / technical accuracy	-	40 %
• Technical quality	-	25 %
• Originality of presentation / visual impact	-	20 %
• Logical presentation of subject / issue presented	-	15 %
